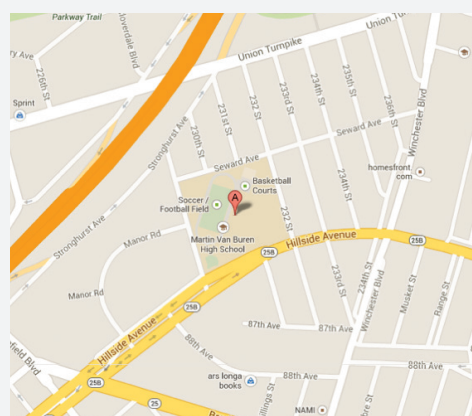

Students attending **Business Technology Early College High School (BTECH)** will learn how to help the world run better using technology to solve everyday world problems. Our students will become expert readers, writers, and critical thinkers with the technical skills to be successful in our modern information-based global economy.

Students have up to six years to earn a high school diploma and an associate degree—free of cost—from Queensborough Community College and hands-on job training and apprenticeship with SAP (an international enterprise software development company). Upon graduation, our students will have the knowledge, skills, career and technical education certifications, and work experience that will make our graduates much more competitive for employment and/or four-year colleges.

## What the school expects of students and parents:

- Students fulfill all pre-requisites and stay on track to begin college course work by the second year.

## What parents and students can expect of the school:

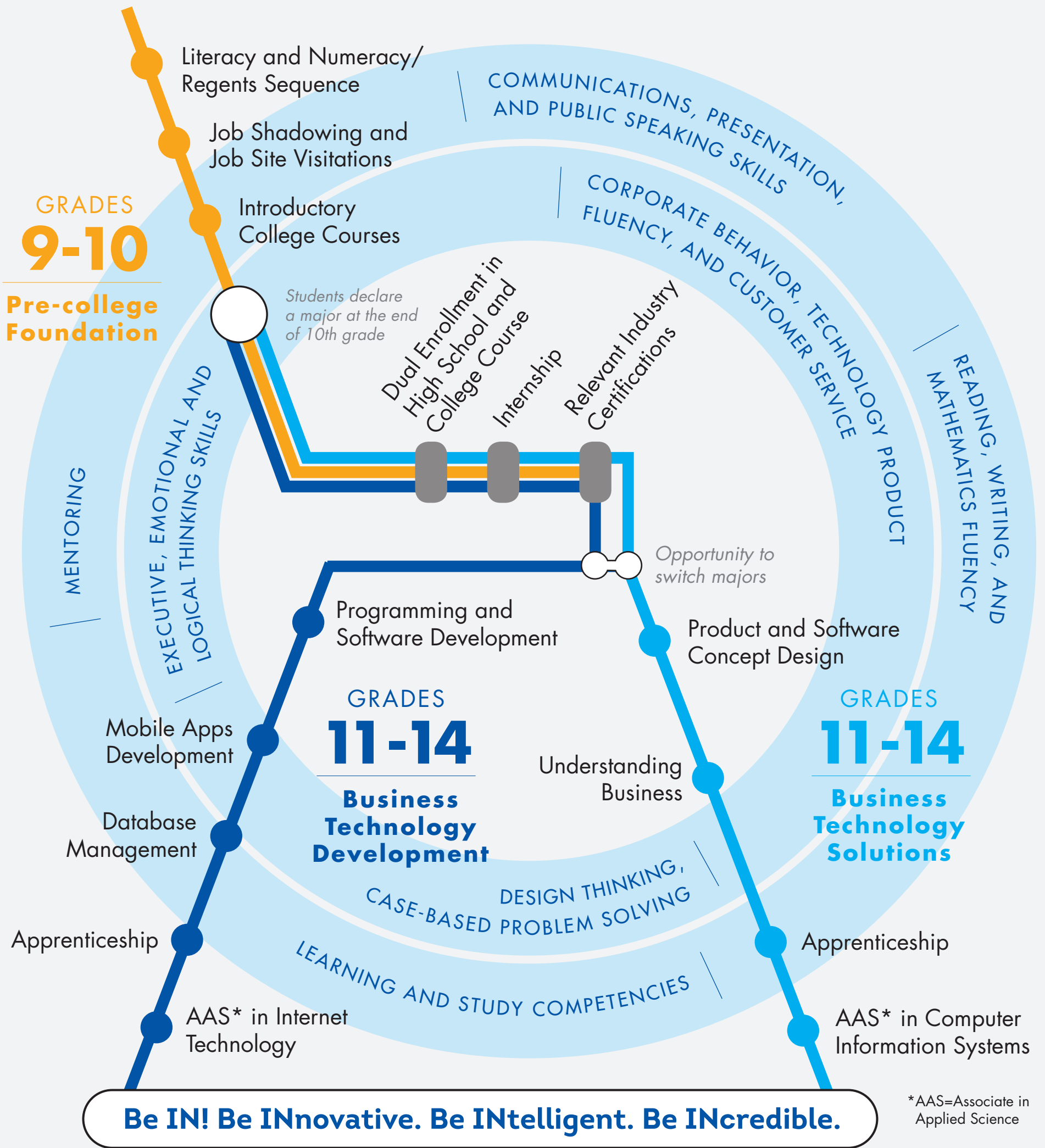
- Open and consistent communication with students' academic advisors and up-to-date information on student learning and progress posted on a secure school website.

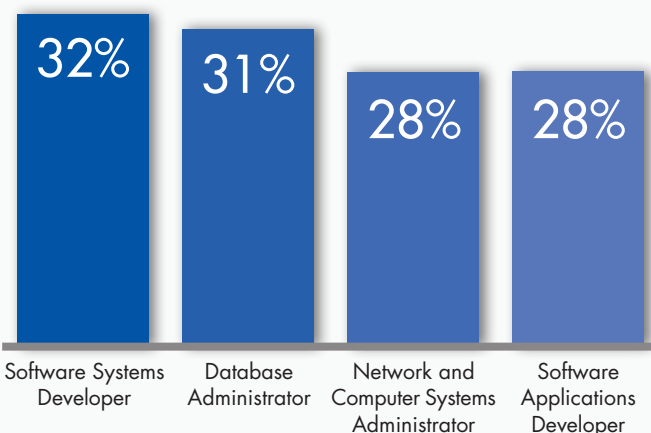

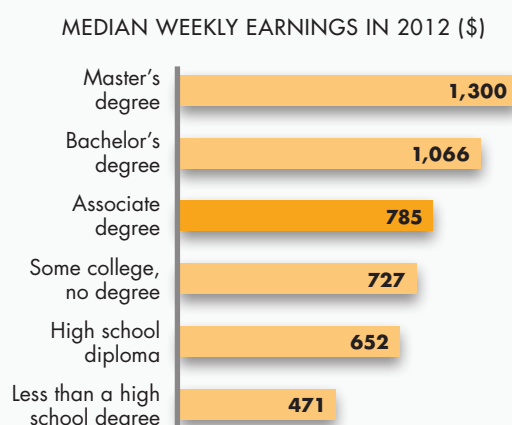
